Call for Projects: Banque de France launches the third edition of its Prize for Young Researchers in Green Finance

Financing the transition to a low carbon economy consistent with the “*well below 2 degrees Celsius*” goal set out in the Paris agreement and promoting environmentally sustainable growth are among the major challenges of our time.

Against this background, further academic research is needed to improve our collective knowledge on the financing of the transition towards a sustainable economy and on the impact of risks related to climate, environmental degradation and loss in biodiversity for the financial sector.

Therefore, in 2018, the Banque de France decided to offer a Prize for Young Researchers in Green Finance, taking the form of a funding of 15000 euros, and is launching today the call for projects of the 3d edition.

- The Prize is intended at Doctorates/PHDs holders, ideally not older than 40 years and affiliated to a French university and/or French academic institution. The call for projects can be downloaded [here](#) and more information on the Prize can be found on the Banque de France website [here](#).

As previous years, the Prize will be awarded in principle at an academic conference to be scheduled before the end of 2020.
